ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

1. **Math in GJPS: Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment**
 - The group held a discussion on K-12 math curriculum, instruction and assessment. Data was shared regarding course failure rates in grades 6-12 Math Courses. We discussed a decrease in the percentage of students failing at the end of the first quarter as compared to end of year failure rates and reflected on possible reasons and components that may have impacted that data. We will continue to monitor this data and reflect on it again at our January meeting, after semester grades have been reported.
 - A discussion that built on the CPM presentation given at the last Student Learning and Achievement Committee meeting was held and Tia Holliman shared about some of the supports that have been put in place to help target student needs and increase student learning.
