A. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

1. **Athletics:** Our boys/girls track, boys volleyball, softball, and baseball teams are still competing
 - Our Softball team plays at 5 PM on May 17th at Pickerington in District Championship
 - Our baseball team will play at 5 PM on May 20th the site has not yet been determined
 - Our boys and girls track teams are competing in Districts this weekend at Hilliard Darby all day
 - The boys' volleyball team plays on Saturday morning May 18th at 10:00 AM at Mount Vernon
2. **Orchestra:** The final GLHS orchestra concert was on Tuesday and it was fabulous. Thanks so much, Mr. Dengel for bringing the chamber orchestra here tonight. It was fantastic.
3. **Band:** On May 2nd and 3rd I had the opportunity to attend performances of the state band competition. It was amazing. I really enjoyed the sight-reading activity where students and directors get a piece of music, study it for four minutes, practice with the director for another four minutes, and then play the piece. It is a great example of an authentic assessment., where feedback and performance happens at the moment.

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4. **Choir:** Final GLHS choir concert is on Sunday, May 19th at 3:00 PM
 - I was also able to attend the state choir competition two weekends ago. It was fabulous. I also attended the sight reading of the A Cappella Choir. This was another example of an authentic assessment.
5. **Herb and Arts Fair:** I attended the Herb n Arts Fair on Saturday, May 3rd. Students did an amazing job planning activities for kids. There were food trucks there and lots of GLHS musicians performing. Local dance studios also put on performances. GLHS student art was also on sale.
6. **Senior Awards/Graduation:** There were over 50 scholarships awarded on May 16 to graduating seniors. We had 3 commended scholars and 1 Merit Finalist.
7. **Note about our Senior Class:** We are very proud of the class of 2019; they are exceptional students from diverse backgrounds and are well prepared for what lies ahead. On May 25th at the Schottenstein Center, 548 seniors will walk across the stage to receive their diplomas. Our seniors are incredibly talented and have excelled in many ways during their time at GLHS. Many of them will be attending college, including some of the top universities in the United States. Others will be entering the workforce looking to make their mark on the world. Some will be entering one of the five branches of the military. I have enjoyed watching the class of 2019 compete and perform on the athletic field, in concerts and plays, and in academic competitions. We hope they remember their time at Gahanna-Lincoln High School fondly and come back to visit.
8. **ESS lunch:** Yesterday, we ate lunch served by ESS students and it was really delightful. Our ESS team of teachers works very hard to individualize instruction and work with students to develop life skills.
 - Our ESS program is featured in OEA magazine this month for the work they do with student yoga sessions.

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9. **The Master Facility Planning Committee:** We will meet with Corna Kokosing and Triad Architects on May 21 where we hope to get a better idea of costs for the new Lincoln. Construction costs of materials and labor are up significantly across the region and the state. We will need to adjust our design because of escalating materials costs increased demand for workers in the trades. We will have a Master Planning Facility meeting on May 24.
10. **Apollo 11:** Two of GLHS graduates will be here on Sunday, May 19 at a screening of their documentary Apollo 11. Todd Miller produced and directed and Matt Morton was the composer of the score. They will both be inducted into the GLHS Hall of Fame on May 20.

B. TREASURER'S REPORT

1. Variance Report:

Our revenue total is 1.31% above estimated or \$1,184,520. The majority of this increase was from increased values on TIF's as noted last month.

Our expenses in total continue to be under budget by .82% or \$750,349. This amount may increase slightly as we wind down the year and remaining budget balances are released.

- The increase in the cost of contracted staff, substitute costs and legal fees remains.
- We are continuing to fall under budget in most spending categories, with salaries and benefits combined under by 4%. The decrease in benefit costs is attributed to the reduction in employees taking the district medical insurance.

Our potential increase in our ending cash balance is \$1.9M at this time, compared to the October 2018 forecast and we will avoid deficit spending for this fiscal year.

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2. **Five-Year Forecast:** I will be presenting our forecast for your approval this evening. Our exact funding increase from the state is still unknown so I used a conservative 1% increase in funding.
3. **Self-Insurance Fund:** The committee has met numerous times and is currently considering multiple options. This includes looking at fully insured plans and different carriers. These discussions will continue in negotiations next week.
