- Ceremonial Walks will take place May 26 – 29, 2020 on the GLHS football field. Participation is OPTIONAL for students and families.
 - In the event of inclement weather (heavy rain, thunder, and lightning), we will move our ceremonial walk to May 30th, May 31st, and June 1st. We will proceed with our ceremonial walk as scheduled if light rain persists. Please plan accordingly and bring an umbrella.
 - On days when weather conditions worsen as the event progresses, we will reschedule the remaining graduates' ceremonial walks for one of our rain dates. We will continually monitor the weather conditions and notify families of postponements or cancellations via email, social media, automated calls, and/or text messages as soon as possible.

6. **Lincoln Elementary Update:** Along with the updates, I have attached a building layout to show you what portion of the building is are A, B, or C.
 - The abandoned storm line was filled in last week.
 - Foundations continued to be placed in area A and perimeter foundations continued in area B.
 - Masonry foundation walls were completed in area C up to 32" high.
 - Electrical rough in has started in area C this week.
 - The waterline for the new building was tapped.

7. **Summer Maintenance Projects:**
 - Royal Manor Elementary sidewalk widening is complete.
 - Royal Manor Elementary and Blacklick Elementary libraries: books have been stored, and shelves and circulation desks have been removed.
 - The Middle School West project will start the first week of June. Signs will be placed at the track early next week to communicate the timeframe the track will be under construction.
 - New HVAC systems will be going in at Goshen Lane Elementary and Royal Manor Elementary. There will also be new flooring going in at Chapelfield Elementary and Middle School East. These projects will take place on May 26th.

B. TREASURER'S REPORT

1. **Cash Balances:** Cash Balances are \$59.0M. The General fund balance (including GF Debt) is \$23.4M vs \$21.4M in the previous year. (See attached report of cash balances and investments by maturity date)

2. **Revenues:**
 - Revenues remain ahead of prior year levels due to increased property tax receipts and Tax abatement revenues. It is projected that FY 2020 receipts will be approximately \$500k higher than estimates and \$4.8M higher than prior year.

3. Expenditures:

- Salaries & Wages are tracking higher than prior year by 3.25%. Forecasted Salaries and Wages will be lower than plan for FY 2020 and favorably impact the May forecast by approximately \$500k.
- Employee benefit costs are tracking lower than forecast. Savings of approximately \$1.2M will be realized. Offsetting the underrun will be transfers required to eliminate projected deficits in the Self Insurance 024 Fund of \$345k.

4. Appropriations:

- No changes at this time.

5. Account Activity

- The CARES Act funding to be received totals \$983,718 of which \$192,289 is allocated for Auxiliary services. A 500 Federal Fund will be created to track expenditures in FY 2021.

6. Activities:

- Budget worksheets have been compiled and incorporated into the May forecast. Adjustments are being made to align spending with the operational and financial impacts of the economic shutdown and distance learning environments.
- Impacts to the Five Year Forecast include:
 - Fiscal Year 2020 reduction in State funding of \$1,667k
 - Estimated reduction in State funding for FY 2021 and FY 2022 of 10%
or \$3.3M is lost revenues
 - Estimated reduction in Pilot and TIF revenues @ 8% due to reduced collections during the economic crisis
 - Delay in collection of real estate tax revenues of 5% for FY 2021 and FY 2022
 - Lower interest earnings due to current and forecasted interest rate environment

- Reduction in Casino revenue of 40% for FY 2021; 20% in FY 2022; 10% in FY 2023
- The Forecast assumes that the School district will be operational for the upcoming school year. If the operational model is abnormal, participation fees, rental income and other fees will be reduced. Expenditures will also require adjustment to offset the impact of lower revenues.
- It is likely that an update to the May Forecast will be required as more information becomes available, eliminating some of the uncertainty at this time.

Owner Contractor Master Agreement with Kaluzne Painting
and Authorizing Work Orders

The Superintendent recommends approval of an Owner-Contractor Master Agreement with Kaluzne Painting to perform painting projects throughout the District. The Superintendent requests authorization to enter into various Work Orders under the Master Agreement for the individual projects for separate buildings.

Rationale:

1. The Gahanna-Jefferson Public School District Board of Education (“Board”) requires ongoing painting services for separate projects and separate buildings throughout the District.

2. Each individual project will be outside the scope of the bidding procedure outlined in R.C. 3313.46, because the work completed on each project will not exceed the \$50,000 statutory threshold.
3. The Superintendent recommends approval of a Master Agreement with Kaluzne Painting to perform the separate, individual painting projects throughout the district not to exceed \$50,000.
4. The Superintendent further requests authority to enter into Work Orders under the Master Agreement, the value of an individual work order not to exceed \$50,000.

The Gahanna-Jefferson Public School District Board resolves as follows:

1. The Master Agreement between the Board and Kaluzne Painting is approved.
2. The Superintendent and Treasurer are authorized to execute the Master Agreement on the Board's behalf.
3. The Superintendent and Treasurer are further authorized to enter into and execute Work Orders for projects where the value of such Work Order does not exceed \$50,000, and to agree to and execute Change Orders to Work Orders, provided that the total contract sum does not exceed \$50,000.

4. Graduation Contract

The Gahanna-Jefferson Board of Education approved the agreement with Jerome Schottenstein Center to use their facilities for Lincoln High School's commencement ceremonies on May 29, 2021 at a cost not to exceed \$24,775, to be paid out of the general fund.

5. Bleachers – Middle School West

The Gahanna-Jefferson Board of Education approved Farnham Equipment Company to deliver and install new bleachers at Middle School West Athletic Field at a cost not to exceed \$59,116, to be paid out of the permanent improvement (PI) fund.

6. Cabinets and Sinks – Chapelfield Elementary
