- 2. Sections 153.65 through .71 of the Ohio Revised Code prescribes a qualifications-based selection process, which is required to be followed by public entities when professional design services are needed.
- 3. In accordance with the statutory process, the Superintendent publicly advertised and issued a request for qualifications for professional design services and, with the assistance of an evaluation committee consisting of administrators, staff and community members, evaluated the statements of qualifications submitted by professional design firms.
- 4. Following this evaluation, the District identified the top three firms, ultimately ranking the Architect to be most qualified to provide the required professional design services.
- 5. Upon approval of the Board, the Superintendent will request a pricing proposal from the Architect and negotiate a contract with the Architect to perform the required services for fair and reasonable compensation and present the negotiated contract to the Board for approval.

The Board of Education resolves as follows:

- 1. The Board selects the Architect as the firm most qualified to perform the required design and construction administration services for the Project.
- 2. The Board authorizes the Superintendent, working with other administrators and legal counsel, to negotiate a contract with the Architect to perform these services and to present the negotiated contract to the Board for approval.
