Summer School High School Class Descriptions - 2019 (Physical Education, Health, Speech – new credit) (English, Math, Social Studies, Science - make-up credit)

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Daily attendance is important. Each school day is equal to approximately one week of class during the regular school year. Courses in summer school follow the regular graded courses of study as approved by the Gahanna-Jefferson Board of Education. Classes have time requirements imposed by the Ohio Department of Education. All students must complete the 60 hours of classroom instruction. Students are expected to be able to attend all days of class. If an emergency or illness arises that means a student will miss one day of class, the student will work with the teacher to make up the time.

Please do not enroll in summer school if vacations, camps, sports, or other commitments will conflict with attendance in summer school. Students will **NOT** be released early from class to attend sports camps, retreats, tournaments, or competitions. This is considered an UNEXCUSED activity. State law requires a minimum mandatory attendance.

Students withdrawn due to excessive attendance problems or for disciplinary reasons will not receive credit for the class and will not receive a refund.

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent. We do not provide summer school transportation for high school students.

All classes will be held at Lincoln High School, 140 South Hamilton Road. Room assignments (unless otherwise noted) will be posted in the front lobby of the high school on the first day of class for each session. Enrollment in all classes is limited. Registrations will be accepted in the order in which they are received.

All classes must meet a minimum enrollment in order to be offered.

Gahanna-Jefferson students on the free lunch program can take summer **make-up** classes at no charge. New credit classes **do not** qualify for fee adjustment for those on the free lunch program. Students on reduced lunch must pay 15% of the total cost of **make-up** classes. New credit classes **do not** qualify for fee adjustment for those on the reduced lunch program.

For financial reasons, a federal food service program is not available during the summer.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY (except for Physical Education).

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (Lifetime Sports and Activities) – FOR NEW OR MAKE-UP CREDIT. (Grades 9-12). (1/4 credit). M/T/W/TH/F. Monday, June 3 – Thursday, June 20, 7:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. FEE: \$245. A small participation fee may be required for bowling and golf. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students/residents.

The major objectives of the course are the physical development of a strong, healthy body and the development of skills and concepts in "lifetime" sports and fitness. Each student will explore a variety of fitness-based activities and will be introduced to a variety of non-traditional lifetime sports and fitness concepts. Students will meet the first day at 7:30 a.m. in the high school auditorium.

FINAL DEADLINE for the Physical Education class registration is Thursday, May 30. Registrations submitted after this date will not be processed.

<u>HEALTH</u> – FOR NEW CREDIT ONLY. (Grades 10-12). (1/2 credit). M/T/W/TH/F. Monday, June 3 – Friday, June 21, 7:30 – 11:30 am. SITE: Gahanna Lincoln High School. Room J370. Fee: \$245. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

Do you want to take a class that deals with <u>REAL</u> teen issues? Health is a fun, relevant and practical semester course in which students will learn essential health concepts and practice essential skills necessary to adopt, practice, and maintain health-enhancing behaviors. Topics covered include Mental Health & Wellness, Alcohol & Drugs, Diseases, Human Sexuality & Healthy Relationships and Nutrition.

This summer school course will meet the ½ credit graduation requirement for Health, is limited to 28 students, and will be scheduled on a first request basis. **Interested students will need to commit to the following:** 

- Attend a meeting immediately after school on <u>Thursday, May 2<sup>th</sup> in J370</u> to get directions for the Wellness Project or contact the teacher via e-mail (<u>LoweryC@gjps.org</u>) by that date to arrange a meeting.
- Choose a Wellness Goal and get it approved by the teacher before <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 10<sup>th</sup></u>.
- Begin working on achieving a Wellness Goal no later than Monday, May 13th.
- Complete the Wellness Project Graphic Organizer and turn it in at the beginning of class on Monday, June 3 (first day of class) so students will have time to complete the entire project.
- Have internet access outside of class and check the teacher's portal for information daily.
- Spend time to complete <u>daily</u> homework outside of class. Each day of class equals over one
  week of the regular school year, so there will be daily assignments to complete at home.

Given the fact that the Health class offered during the summer is scheduled to meet at least 4 hours each day, students must attend <u>all</u> classes in order to earn credit in the course. In the event a student has need for an excused absence(s), he/she will need to arrange make-up time with the teacher.

FINAL DEADLINE for Health class registration is Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. Registrations submitted after this date will not be processed.

<u>SPEECH</u> – FOR NEW CREDIT ONLY. (Grades 9-12). (1/2 credit). M/T/W/TH/F. Monday, July 1 - Monday, July 15. 7:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. OR 12:00 p.m. - 5:00 pm. No class on Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. Class will be held on Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup> and students are expected to attend class that day. An additional Speech class will be offered Tuesday, July 16 – Friday, July 26. Class will be held July 16-July 25 from 7:00 am – 12:15 pm. On Friday, July 26, class will be held from 7:00 am – 3:30 pm. There will be a lunch break from 12:00-12:30 pm. SITE: Gahanna Lincoln High School. Room H188. Fee: \$245. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students. **PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.** 

Speech is a required semester class usually taken freshman or sophomore year of high school.

Topics and assignments will include: Introduction Speech, Demonstration Speech, Special Person Speech, Career Speech, Parliamentary Procedure, Oral Interpretation, Group Discussion, Sales Pitch, Persuasion Speech, Job Interview/Resume, Final Speech, and a few tests on the content.

This **rigorous** and **relevant** summer school course will meet the ½ credit graduation requirement for Speech, <u>is limited to 15 students</u>, and will be scheduled on a first request basis. Interested students will need to commit to the following:

Willingness to meet with the teacher in May (either before school, during lunch, or after school) to go over the career speech information and shadow someone in their career before they meet in the classes starting on July 1 or July 16. They will also need to select a Persuasion and Final Speech topic of their choice and be willing to print or bring three sources for their Persuasion Speech and ten sources for their Final Speech. The students will be given 10 instructional hours for this time, which is why they will only need to meet for two weeks during the summer. Students will be contacted via e-mail by the teacher in early May to set up a meeting time.

There will be some homework each night, which will include outlines and practicing presentations.

Given the fact that speech class offered during the summer is scheduled to meet at least 5 hours each day, students must attend <u>all</u> classes in order to earn credit in the course. In the event a student has need for an excused absence, he will need to arrange make-up time with the teacher.

FINAL DEADLINE for Speech class registration is Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. Registrations submitted after this date will not be processed.

Make-up credit classes. These classes are available to GJPS residents/students only.

<u>English 9</u> - For Make-Up Credit. June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up English 9 for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>English 10</u> - For Make-Up Credit. June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up English 10 for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

English 11 - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 11-12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up English 11 for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

English 12 - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up English 12 for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

Algebra I - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. OR 12:00 - 4:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Algebra I for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>Algebra II</u> - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically designed for those students who need to make up Algebra II for one credit. The class will include some online coursework during the class session. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

Geometry - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Geometry for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>Pre-Calculus</u> - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 10 – June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Pre-Calculus for one credit. This class will consist of working independently online with coursework. A teacher will be available to answer questions. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>Modern World History</u> - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-11). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is designed for those students who need to make up Modern World History for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>U.S. History</u> - For Make-up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 10 – June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up U.S. History for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>U.S. Government</u> - For Make-up Credit. (Gr. 12). June 10– June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up U.S. Government for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>Physical Science</u> - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. OR 12:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. \$245. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up Physical Science for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.

<u>Biology</u> - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 10 - June 28, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$245. This course is specifically designed for students who need to make up Biology for one credit. PLEASE NOTE: ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHARGED CHROMEBOOK TO CLASS DAILY.
