ATTENDANCE AND DISCIPLINE POLICY

We are pleased to provide the opportunity for students to attend Journey to Learning classes during the summer session. The success of the program is directly related to the ability of our staff to create the best possible learning environment. To assure the opportunity for each student to enjoy their summer school experience we ask that students and parents be aware of the following policies:

ATTENDANCE:

Each class is very important and time is limited, so attendance is expected. Attendance is recorded daily for each class.

PROPER BEHAVIOR:

Students are to conduct themselves in accordance with the rules and regulations they followed during the regular school year. Although informal attire is permissible during summer school, standards of good taste will be maintained. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and continued violation of the rules may result in disciplinary action including dismissal from the program without credit or refund of fees.

Elementary Course Catalog – 2018

Courses offered Monday through Friday 8:00 am – 10:00 am AND/OR 10:00 am – 12:00 pm. Classes are open to out-of-district students (except where noted) on a space available basis (\$80.00 out-of-district fee).

Summer school classes are designed for those who may have struggled during the school year and need reinforcement before moving on to the next grade (except for Chinese enrichment). Even if you indicated you would participate in summer opportunities through your elementary school, you still need to register for summer school.

Preschool Experience (for children ages 3-5 not eligible for Kindergarten). This class is offered at CLARK HALL, Suite B.

*This course is designed for children ages 3-5 who are **currently** enrolled in Gahanna-Jefferson Public Schools Preschool Program and will NOT be going to Kindergarten. BUS TRANSPORTATION IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR THIS COURSE.*

This course will provide preschool aged students with a multi-sensory approach to learning through a language rich environment, experiential hands-on activities, and repeated practice with preschool concepts. All supplies will be provided. There are a limited number of spots available for this course. Fee: \$120

Pre-Kindergarten Experience (for children age 5 by August 1, 2018). This class is offered at High Point Elementary.

This course is designed for children who may need additional experience in a pre-school environment before entering kindergarten. STUDENTS WHO WILL ATTEND GJPS FOR THE FIRST TIME DURING THE 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED FOR KINDERGARTEN BEFORE REGISTERING FOR THE PRE-KINDERGARTEN EXPERIENCE. BUS TRANSPORTATION IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR THIS COURSE.

It is especially recommended for students planning to enter kindergarten who have never attended pre-school. The following skills will be emphasized during this class: Social awareness, working with manipulatives, upper-and-lower-case letter recognition, color recognition, similarities/differences, and arts and crafts activities. All supplies will be provided. Fee: \$120

Kindergarten Enhancement This class is offered at High Point Elementary.

For children who have completed kindergarten and are planning to attend first grade.

Students will participate in readiness activities reinforcing the following skills: letter and sound recognition, number identification with the use of manipulatives, and shape recognition. All supplies will be provided. Fee: \$120

Reading Improvement Grades 1-4 These classes are offered at High Point Elementary.

Small group classes at each grade level.

Refine and improve your child's reading skills with the varied and stimulating activities developed to meet the individual needs of the student through small group activities. A variety of literature will be used to develop competency in reading skills such as comprehension, word attack, and vocabulary development to be successful at the next grade level. Fee: \$120

Math Improvement Grades 1-4 These classes are offered at High Point Elementary.

Small group classes at each grade level.

Improve your child's understanding of math concepts through individualized and small group activities with an emphasis on building number sense and place value through the use of manipulatives and hands-on activities. Fee: \$120

Enrichment Class: Introduction to Chinese Language and Cultures (Grades 1-4 only). This class is offered at High Point Elementary.

Offered June 4-15 from 8:00-am 10:00 am (2 week class).

Students will have introductory lessons in Mandarin Chinese and practice the art of Chinese character drawing. They will also learn about Chinese customs and participate in activities unique to the Chinese culture. This class is open to students that have had some instruction in Chinese as well as those that are new to the language. Fee: \$65

*If paying with a credit card, complete the registration form and submit the form using either the mail or drop off options above. Please read the following for credit card payments:

Students must be registered for a class before a fee appears in Home Access. Registrations will be entered within 48 hours after we receive them. You will receive an email when the student has been registered. **If the fee is not paid through home access within 72 hours after the email has been sent, the student will be withdrawn from the class. *Canceled checks serve as confirmation of registration.

*Registrants will be notified in case of course changes.

*Transportation cannot be provided for students in Preschool OR Pre-K Experience classes.

*A federal food service program is not available during the summer.

NOTE: Once the registration is mailed, there will **NOT** be a confirmation sent to you. Your child is registered unless you are contacted. Class assignments will be posted by the front door on the first day of class.

To provide support for parents enrolling their children in the Journey To Learning Summer Program, arrangements, free of charge, have been made to provide transportation services for Kindergarten Enhancement through 8th grade students. **We cannot transport Preschool or Pre-Kindergarten students. - * District buildings will not be open for waiting areas.
- * All students requesting transportation services will be expected to comply with district guidelines for appropriate behavior while at the bus stop and riding the bus.
