**ATTENDANCE AND DISCIPLINE POLICY**

We are pleased to provide the opportunity for students to attend Journey to Learning classes during the summer session. To assure the opportunity for each student to enjoy their summer school experience we ask that students and parents be aware of the following policies:

**ATTENDANCE:**

Each class is very important and time is limited, so attendance is expected. Attendance is recorded daily for each class.

**PROPER BEHAVIOR:**

Students are to conduct themselves in accordance with the rules and regulations they followed during the regular school year. Although informal attire is permissible during summer school, standards of good taste will be maintained. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and continued violation of the rules may result in disciplinary action including dismissal from the program without credit or refund of fees.

**NOTE:** Once the registration is mailed, there will **NOT** be a confirmation sent to you. Your child is registered unless you are contacted. Class assignments will be posted by the front door on the first day of class.

Title	Description	Fee
<b>Reading &amp; Language Improvement *</b> Grades 5, 6, 7, 8	These courses are designed to provide individualized, small group instruction to improve reading and writing skills. Using a wide variety of fiction and non-fiction materials, students will participate in multiple performance tasks based on individual interest and needs.	\$120
<b>Math Improvement *</b> Grades 5, 6, 7, 8	These courses are designed to help students develop a positive attitude toward math and help students to feel more confident with their math skills. Students will improve their math skills by using manipulatives and hands-on activities in a small group setting with individualized instruction.	\$120

- Students must be registered for a class before a fee appears in Home Access. Registrations will be entered within 48 hours after we receive them. You will receive an email when the student has been registered. **If the fee is not paid through home access within 72 hours after the email has been sent, the student will be withdrawn from the class. ## 2018 SUMMER JOURNEY TO LEARNING TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

To provide support for parents enrolling their children in the Journey To Learning Summer Program, arrangements, free of charge, have been made to provide transportation services for Kindergarten Enhancement through 8th grade students. **We cannot transport Preschool or Pre-Kindergarten students. Busing is for in-district students only.**

### Transportation Guidelines:

- \* Services will be provided free of charge.
- \* Services will be available to students entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade through current 8<sup>th</sup> grade students ONLY.
- \* Services may be utilized on either a one-way or round-trip basis.
- \* District buildings will not be open for waiting areas.
- \* All students requesting transportation services will be expected to comply with district guidelines for appropriate behavior while at the bus stop and riding the bus.
