GENERAL INFORMATION:

Daily attendance is important. Each school day is equal to approximately one week of class during the regular school year. Courses in summer school follow the regular graded courses of study as approved by the Gahanna-Jefferson Board of Education. Classes have time requirements imposed by the Ohio Department of Education. All students must complete the 60 hours of classroom instruction. Students are expected to be able to attend all days of class. If an emergency or illness arises that means a student will miss one day of class, the student will work with the teacher to make up the time.

Please do not enroll in summer school if vacations, camps, sports, or other commitments will conflict with attendance in summer school. Students will **NOT** be released early from class to attend sports camps, retreats, tournaments, or competitions. This is considered an UNEXCUSED activity. State law requires a minimum mandatory attendance.

Students withdrawn due to excessive attendance problems or for disciplinary reasons will not receive credit for the class and will not receive a refund.

All classes will be held at Lincoln High School. Room assignments (unless otherwise noted) will be posted in the front lobby of the high school on the first day of class for each session.

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent. We do not provide summer school transportation for high school students.

Enrollment in all classes is limited. Registrations will be accepted in the order in which they are received.

If a class must be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, or if there is a need to consider an alternative time slot, a phone call will be made to either the home, work, or cell number listed on the registration form to discuss options. Fees will be refunded for cancelled classes.

GJPS parents can verify a student is enrolled by checking Home Access Center. On the left-hand menu, click on schedule. Any summer school classes the student is registered for will appear in 2016-17 schedule. Grades for in-district students will be posted on-line after the completion of the course and can be accessed through the Home Access Center. Click on report cards. Grades for non-GJPS students living in our school district will be mailed.

Gahanna-Jefferson students on the free and reduced lunch program can take summer **make-up** classes or the enrichment classes at no charge. New credit classes do not qualify for fee adjustment for those on the free and reduced lunch programs.

Fees must be paid when registering for classes. **Registration forms will not be accepted without payment.** Full refunds will be processed for cancellations prior to the deadline for enrolling in classes. A \$20 processing fee will be charged for refund requests after the enrollment deadline date.

Allow three (3) days after submitting the registration form (to allow for registration in the class to be entered by the district office). After three days, go to the “Home Access Center” (<http://hac.gjps.org/homeaccess/>) to access your account and make the payment. This option is only available to GJPS students. The following new credit classes will be offered during the 2017 Summer Program:

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (Lifetime Sports and Activities) – FOR NEW OR MAKE-UP CREDIT. (Grades 9-12). (1/4 credit). M/T/W/TH/F. Tuesday, May 30 - Friday, June 16. 7:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. FEE: \$230. A small participation fee may be required for bowling and golf. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students/residents.

The major objectives of the course are the physical development of a strong, healthy body and the development of skills and concepts in “lifetime” sports and fitness. Each student will explore a variety of fitness-based activities and will be introduced to a variety of non-traditional lifetime sports and fitness concepts. **Students will meet the first day at 7:30 a.m. in the high school auditorium.**

FINAL DEADLINE for the Physical Education class registration is Thursday, May 25th.

HEALTH – FOR NEW CREDIT ONLY. (Grades 10-12). (1/2 credit). M/T/W/TH/F. Tuesday, May 30 – Friday, June 16. Class will be held from 7:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. May 30 - June 8. Class will then meet from 7:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. June 9-16. SITE: Gahanna Lincoln High School. Room J370. Fee: \$230. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students.

Do you want to take a class that deals with **REAL** teen issues? Do you want to learn skills to help you not just survive but thrive during adolescence? Do you like to have fun while learning? Do you enjoy learning in a variety of ways through activities, discussions, speakers, videos, and projects? Health is a fun, relevant and practical semester course in which students will learn essential health concepts and practice essential skills necessary to adopt, practice, and maintain health-enhancing behaviors. Topics covered include Mental Health & Wellness, Alcohol, Tobacco & Other Drugs, Diseases, Human Sexuality & Healthy Relationships and Nutrition & Fitness.

This summer school course will meet the ½ credit graduation requirement for Health, **is limited to 28 students**, and will be scheduled on a first request basis. Interested students will need to commit to the following:

- Attend a meeting immediately after school on **Thursday, May 4th in J370** to get directions for the Wellness Project or contact the teacher via e-mail (LoweryC@gips.org) by that date to arrange a meeting.
- Choose a Wellness goal and get it approved by the teacher before **Friday, May 12th**.
- Begin working on achieving a Wellness Goal no later than **Monday, May 15th**.
- Complete the **Wellness Project Graphic Organizer** and turn it in the beginning of class on **Tuesday, May 30th** (first day of class) so students will have time to complete the entire project.
- Have internet access outside of class and check the teacher's portal for information daily.
- Spend time to complete **daily** homework outside of class. Each day of class equals over one week of the regular school year, so there will be assignments to complete at home daily.

Given the fact that the Health class offered during the summer **is scheduled to meet at least 4 hours each day, students must attend all classes in order to earn credit in the course.** In the event a student has need for an excused absence(s), he/she will need to arrange make-up time with the teacher.

FINAL DEADLINE for Health class registration is Friday, May 12th.

SPEECH – FOR NEW CREDIT ONLY. (Grades 9-12). (1/2 credit). M/T/W/TH/F.

Monday, June 26 – Monday, July 10. 7:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. OR 12:00 p.m. - 5:00 pm. No class on Tuesday, July 4th. Class will be held on Monday, July 3 (attendance required to complete class and receive credit). SITE: Gahanna Lincoln High School. Room H188. Fee: \$230. This class is open only to Gahanna-Jefferson students.

Speech is a required semester class usually taken freshman or sophomore year of high school.

Topics and assignments will include: Introduction Speech, Demonstration Speech, Special Person Speech, Career Speech, Parliamentary Procedure, Oral Interpretation, Group Discussion, Sales Pitch, Persuasion Speech, Job Interview/Resume, Final Speech, and a few tests on the content.

This **rigorous and relevant** summer school course will meet the ½ credit graduation requirement for Speech, **is limited to 15 students**, and will be scheduled on a first request basis. Interested students will need to commit to the following:

- Willingness to meet with the teacher in May (either before school, during lunch, or after school) to go over the career speech information and shadow someone in their career before they meet in the classes starting on June 26. They will also need to select a Persuasion and Final Speech topic of their choice and be willing to print or bring **three sources** for their Persuasion Speech and **ten sources** for their Final Speech. The students will be given **10 instructional hours** for this time, which is why they will only need to meet for two weeks during the summer. Students will be contacted via e-mail by the teacher in early May to set up a meeting time.

There will be some homework each night, which will include outlines and practicing presentations.

Given the fact that speech class offered during the summer **is scheduled to meet 5 hours each day, students must attend all classes in order to earn credit in the course.** In the event a student has need for an excused absence, he will need to arrange make-up time with the teacher.

FINAL DEADLINE for Speech class registration is Friday, June 9th.

High School Classes (All of the following are for make-up credit only.)

These classes are available to GJPS residents/students only.

English 9 - For Make-Up Credit. June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up English 9 for one credit.

English 10 - For Make-Up Credit. June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up English 10 for one credit.

English 11 - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 11-12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up English 11 for one credit.

English 12 - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up English 12 for one credit.

Algebra I - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. OR 12:00 – 4:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Algebra I for one credit.

Algebra II - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically designed for those students who need to make up Algebra II for one credit. The class will include some online coursework during the class session.

Geometry - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Geometry for one credit.

Pre-Calculus - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 5 – June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically for those students who need to make up Pre-Calculus for one credit. This class will consist of working independently online with coursework. A teacher will be available to answer questions.

Modern World History - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9-11). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is designed for those students who need to make up Modern World History for one credit.

U.S. History - For Make-up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 5 – June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up U.S. History for one credit.

U.S. Government - For Make-up Credit. (Gr. 12). June 5 – June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up U.S. Government for one credit.

Physical Science - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 9). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. OR 12:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. \$230. This course will meet the requirements for those students who need to make up Physical Science for one credit.

Biology - For Make-Up Credit. (Gr. 10-12). June 5 - June 23, M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$230. This course is specifically designed for students who need to make up Biology for one credit.

OHIO GRADUATION TEST (OGT) June 5-9

The OGT classes are available to GJPS residents/students only. Please be aware that attendance is mandatory.

Students needing to take two OGT tests will take one OGT test on Monday, June 12 and the second test on Tuesday, June 13 (in the morning).

Social Studies, Science, Math - June 5 - 9. 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. \$60. This course is designed to help students prepare for the social studies, science, and/or math sections of the 10th grade OGT. Students will have the opportunity to take the Social Studies OGT, Science OGT, and/or Math OGT upon successful completion of the class. **The OGT exams will be administered in the morning on June 12th.**

Writing/Reading - June 5 -9. 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. \$60. This course is designed to help students prepare for the writing and/or reading sections of the 10th grade OGT. Students will have the opportunity to take the Writing OGT and/or Reading OGT upon successful completion of the class. **The OGT exams will be administered in the morning on June 12th.**

FINAL DEADLINE for make-up and OGT class registration is Wednesday, May 31st.

Enrichment Classes

Songwriting and Arranging (Grades 9-12) June 19-30. M/T/W/TH/F, 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. \$60. Many students are interested in songwriting, composition, arranging, and orchestrating music. This course provides an opportunity to learn, create, and receive feedback on taking your music from idea to reality. Students should have an understanding of standard music notation. Students will learn basic music notation software to use during and after the course.

Latin Philharmonic! (Grades 9-12) June 19-30. M/T/W/TH/F, 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. \$60. Travel to Central and South America this summer through the unique rhythms, melodies, and harmonies of this musically rich area of the world. Open to students who play stringed, wind*, or percussion instruments. There will be a concert at the end of the session. Orchestra students will have opportunities to experiment on electric stringed instruments while learning this unique musical genre. Transposing wind instruments may need to rewrite their parts.
