College Bound SENIORS - it is that time of year: IF you have an Early November 1st deadline from your respective colleges that you are sending applications you have some additional business to take care of. **Please remember the following steps:**

1. To go to your Naviance student account and click on the ***“Colleges tab”*** at the top- right side of your page....go to ***“HOME page”*** and update your list of ***“I'm applying to”*** to order your transcripts (second box on the left side).
2. As soon as that is done, bring in your money (\$2.00 per college) to the College Counter drawer in the Guidance Department and complete the **half tan sheet** and
3. If you requested a teacher to write a letter of Recommendation on your behalf, go to the second box on the left ***“Apply to Colleges”*** scroll down to the second box and click on ***“Letters of Recommendation”*** to invite your teacher into upload their letter. For any questions or concerns, please come to the Guidance Department. Please remember the College admission office will not review your application materials until all supporting documents are received and your file is complete. You must give your counselors time to get everything done, so please don't wait until the last day in October to do this if you have a NOVEMBER 1st deadline. We need a minimum of 5 business days to assure everything goes out on time.

NOTE: As an additional reminder, **your test scores** need to be sent directly from the **ACT or SAT test** centers to your colleges. **Please make sure you have taken care of this! Thank you from your School Counselors!**
