

Gahanna Middle South: Seventh Grade Supply List 2017-2018

ALL CLASSES

- 2 boxes of tissues for your **homeroom** class
- **GIRLS:** Alcohol-free Hand sanitizer to **homeroom class**
- **BOYS:** Sanitizing wipes for **homeroom class**
- Pencils –two boxes (**one box for your homeroom class**)
- Pencil pouch
- Glue Sticks
- One two-inch binder with dividers or accordion file for language arts, social studies, and related arts classes
- Colored pencils, pens, and pencils
- 2 pocket folders with prongs/brads (one for Health class)
- Combination lock for school locker AND for physical ed. locker
- Headphones
- Physical education shirt (purchased at school)
- Metric ruler (**OPTIONAL**)
- Scissors (**OPTIONAL**)
- Hand held pencil sharpener(**OPTIONAL**)
- Notebook paper (loose leaf) (**OPTIONAL**)

MATH 7/ACCELERATED MATH

- Graph paper (1/4 inch, loose leaf)
- Quad ruled notebook or composition book, 100-page minimum
- Separate math folder OR math binder
- Calculator: Suggested (TI-30XIIS)

ALGEBRA

- ¼ inch graph paper notebook
- Loose-leaf ¼ inch graph paper
- A 1-inch binder with 5 dividers
- Graphing calculator (TI-84 Plus recommended)
 - There are a limited number of school graphing calculators available for use if needed. Students can get by for the majority of the year with a scientific calculator (Texas Instruments brand, particularly the TI-30XIIS model recommended).

SCIENCE:

- Mead Five Star College Ruled (or generic equivalent) 1 subject notebook (**ruled, 8.5” x 11”**) is *needed because in this brand it is 8.5 x 11 inches, which works well for pasting letter-size handouts into our science journals. Composition notebooks are too small and do not have enough pages for our needs.*
- Folder for science only
- One 9-volt battery
- Students should also bring in the following items in a SEPARATE PENCIL POUCH* that will stay in the science classroom:
 1. 2 bottles of Elmer’s glue
 2. Colored pencils
 3. Handful of sharpened pencils
 4. Red, green, or purple grading pen
 5. Highlighter
 6. Scissors
 7. 1-2 black Sharpies(*If you do not have a second pencil pouch, your teacher will provide you with a Ziploc bag to store your materials.)

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Pencils
- College ruled, single subject notebook
- Loose leaf paper or single subject notebook
- colored pencils/markers
- notecards
- folder (brads optional)
- highlighters (green, yellow, orange)

LANGUAGE ARTS

- A shared binder two-inch binder with dividers or accordion file with social studies class and related arts
- 2 composition books
- Highlighters (multi-color)
- Pens (blue or black AND red, purple, or dark pink)
- Pencils (mechanical or pre-sharpened)
- Folder (brads preferred)

ART

- 9 x 12 Sketchbook with at least 25 pages (no lined paper) Returning art students may use last year’s sketchbooks if there are enough empty pages (drawing pencils optional)
- 1 pack of mini HOT glue sticks
