7. Amended Agreement for the OASBO 457 Deferred Compensation Plan

Approve the following resolution.

Resolution to Restate the Ohio Association of School
Business Officials 457 Deferred Compensation Plan

WHEREAS, Gahanna-Jefferson City School District has previously adopted the Ohio Association of School Business Officials (“OASBO”) 457 Deferred Compensation Plan (the “Plan”), a retirement plan (the “plan”) under Section 457(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”);

WHEREAS, OASBO last provided its member school districts with an amended and restated Plan, effective as of April 1, 2017, for adoption as the Plan;

WHEREAS, the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement Act (SECURE ACT) and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES ACT) of 2020 would, in relevant part, require the Gahanna-Jefferson City School District to amend the Plan to ensure compliance with Section 457(b) of the Code and the regulations thereunder; and

WHEREAS, Gahanna-Jefferson City School District desires to amend and restate the Plan;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT: Effective as of May 19, 2022, the Board of Gahanna–Jefferson City School District (the “Board”) authorizes Gahanna-Jefferson City School District) to adopt the Plan as amended and restated for such federal legislation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: the Board authorizes the school business official of Gahanna–Jefferson City School District to execute the Plan.

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8. Life Insurance

Approve the One America (through META’s Purchasing Cooperative) proposal for fully insured life insurance coverage for calendar year 2022, effective July 1, 2022. The Insurance Committee reviewed and recommended the change in insurance provider. The Board authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to negotiate the terms, conditions and execute documents necessary to finalize the contract on behalf of the Board. This will result in a slight premium decrease to employees and the Board.
