

NEW Ohio Department of Health QUARANTINE GUIDANCE

AS OF 8/6/21

IF POSSIBLY EXPOSED TO A POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19,
QUARANTINE IS **NOT NECESSARY** IN K-12 SCHOOL SETTINGS IF:



- ✓ You were wearing a **MASK** consistently and correctly.
- ✓ You were at least **3 FEET AWAY** from the exposure. (In GJPS schools, 3 feet of social distancing is practiced to the greatest extent possible but not guaranteed.)
- ✓ The school has documented **COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOLS** in place. (All GJPS schools meet this requirement.)

IN ADDITION:

Individuals who show proof of being **FULLY VACCINATED** do not need to quarantine.

These guidelines only apply to exposure occurring **IN A SCHOOL SETTING**. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated and exposed **OUTSIDE** of the school setting should quarantine from in-person learning and extracurricular activities.
