

Elementary Chinese Enrichment Program for 2022-23

All classes begin the week of September 12, 2022

Classes may reach capacity. We take students on a first-come, first-served basis. **Registrations will be accepted only through TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2022.**

Registration fee for Chinese Enrichment is \$70* for the academic year. Transportation to the program before school (grade 2) and after school (grades 3-5) is the responsibility of the family.

Participation in the Elementary Chinese Enrichment program is voluntary. Continued student participation will be based on appropriate attendance, class behavior, and academic progress. Students who continue with Chinese each year through middle school can receive high school credit for Chinese I but they must complete BOTH 6th and 7th grade Chinese. In 8th grade, they may be eligible to take Chinese II for high school credit.

CHINESE ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Please review the appropriate grade level information below before registering.

2nd Grade “Panda”

This is an Introductory Chinese language class for 2nd graders. This unique program gives students the opportunity to learn about another language and culture while providing some basic second grade math assistance. Goals of the program are for students to do basic math in linguistically and culturally appropriate Chinese, interact with a Chinese speaker, and exchange simple information in Chinese properly. The Panda classes meet before school twice per week.

This year, Goshen Lane Elementary students will take the Panda class at Royal Manor Elementary. Transportation of Goshen Lane students to the Panda class at Royal Manor is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Students can enter the building at **7:10 a.m.** Once class is over, students will then take the shuttle bus from Royal Manor to Goshen Lane for school. The shuttle bus will leave Royal Manor at **7:50 a.m.** All Panda classes will be held from **7:15-7:45 a.m.** Students can enter the building at **7:10 a.m.**

Classes will be held as follows:

Blacklick Elementary – Monday and Wednesday – 1st class will start Monday, September 12
Chapelfield Elementary – Tuesday and Thursday – 1st class will start Tuesday, September 13
Goshen Lane Elementary – Monday and Wednesday – 1st class will start Monday, September 12 (at Royal Manor)
High Point Elementary – Monday and Wednesday – 1st class will start Monday, September 12
Jefferson Elementary – Tuesday and Thursday – 1st class will start Tuesday, September 13
Lincoln Elementary – Tuesday and Thursday – 1st class will start Tuesday, September 13
Royal Manor Elementary – Monday and Wednesday – 1st class will start Monday, September 12

3rd grade – “Dragon”

The Dragon class is an after school Chinese language class for third graders. Your child can continue their language development to learn more about Mandarin Chinese language and culture. The Dragon classes will begin on **Monday, September 12, 2022**. The classes will meet every **Monday and Thursday** after school from **2:25-3:25 p.m.** at each elementary school.

Note for Goshen Lane: Goshen Lane students will take the Dragon class at Royal Manor from **2:25-3:25 p.m.** Students will take the shuttle bus from Goshen Lane to Royal Manor at **2:20 p.m.** Transportation home of Goshen Lane students is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. There will not be a shuttle bus going back to Goshen Lane once the class ends.

4th grade – “Phoenix”

Fourth graders interested in learning Chinese language and culture can participate in the Phoenix class. This class is designed for students previously in the Chinese Enrichment program as well as students just beginning their study of the language and culture. The fourth grade Phoenix class will meet every **Tuesday and Friday** after school from **2:25-3:25 p.m.** at each elementary school. The classes will begin on **Tuesday, September 13, 2022**.

Note for Goshen Lane: Goshen Lane students will take the Dragon class at Royal Manor from **2:25-3:25 p.m.** Students will take the shuttle bus from Goshen Lane to Royal Manor at **2:20 p.m.** Transportation home of Goshen Lane students is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. There will not be a shuttle bus going back to Goshen Lane once the class ends.

5th grade – “Kirin”

Fifth graders interested in learning Chinese language and culture can participate in the Kirin class. This class is designed for students previously in the Chinese Enrichment program as well as students just beginning their study of the language and culture. The fifth grade Kirin class will meet every **Wednesday** after school from **2:25-3:40 p.m.** at each elementary. The classes will begin on **Wednesday, September 14, 2022**. By the end of the fifth grade year, students should be well prepared to begin the middle school Chinese program.

Please note for Goshen Lane: Goshen Lane students will take the Kirin class at Royal Manor from **2:25-3:40 p.m.** Students will take the shuttle bus from Goshen Lane to Royal Manor at **2:20 p.m.** Transportation home of Goshen Lane student participants' is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. There will not be a shuttle bus going back to Goshen Lane once the class ends.
