<p>Science - <i>all students need the following supplies.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 composition notebook- <u>for Blankenship it needs to be quad ruled (graph paper)</u> ● 2 glue sticks ● Durable (not paper) 2 pocket folder with prongs ● 1 dry erase markers ● 2 highlighters
<p>Social Studies -<i>all students need the following supplies.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Colored pens for note taking (non "bleeding", please) ● 1 dry-erase marker ● 2 highlighters (different colors) ● 1 subject spiral notebook ● "Composition" notebook (different from the spiral) ● 2 pocket folder with prongs (for Mrs. Hollinger only)
